**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE
DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF STRUTHERS AND
THE STRUTHERS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE
PROVISION OF A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Struthers (the “City”) for the Struthers Police Department to provide to the Struthers City School District (the “District”) a School Resource Officer (“SRO”);

WHEREAS, a SRO will benefit students, teachers and administrative staff by providing an on-site law enforcement presence at the City’s schools; and

WHEREAS, the attached Memorandum of Understanding (the “MOU”) between the City and the District establishes the needed commitment and support from both institutions to provide a series of guidelines and policies relevant to the performance of the SRO and will be the guiding document that officers, school administrators, and students and their caregivers look to for structure and accountability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$'s of all members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to execute the MOU for the provision of a SRO to the District in accordance with the terms and conditions contained therein.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: A delay in the effective date of this Ordinance will result in detriment to the economic health, safety and welfare of the Struthers community at large. Accordingly, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
