## A RESOLUTION REQUIRING PAYROLL DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR ALL CITY OF STRUTHERS EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMEGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Government and State of Ohio permit employers in the State of Ohio to require payroll direct deposit for all employees.

WHEREAS, the City of Struthers mandates that all employees be required to participate in payroll direct deposit. The City will follow all requirements spelled in in the Electronic Funds Transfer Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>'s of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1:** Direct deposits are Electronic Funds Transfers (EFT) governed federally by the Electronic Funds Transfer Act. All direct deposits are handles through the Automated Clearing House used by all U.S institutions

**SECTION 2:** The City agrees to follow all requirements spelled in any applicable laws mandated by the State of Ohio and the Federal Government.

**SECTION 3:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace and the health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Struthers, Ohio. Said emergency exists by reason ease of commerce in light of the recent COVID-19 pandemic; and, as such, this resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
