Ordinance

NO. 22-030

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF A NON-CLASSIFIED PART-TIME DISPATCHER OBSERVER/TRAINEE, SETTING HOURS AND WAGES FOR SAID POSITION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 16-055 AND ANY ORDINANCE INCOSISTANT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$'s of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Council deems it necessary to create the position of a Non-Classified part-time Dispatcher Observer/Trainee, setting hours and wages for said position, effective upon passage.

SECTION 2: That said payment shall be the amount of \$10.00 per hour and that said pay rate shall be effective upon passage.

SECTION 3: Said scheduled hours shall not exceed twenty-eight (28).

SECTION 4: It is understood that said person is eligible for no fringe benefits and shall work an average of twenty-eight (28) hours per week, not to exceed one thousand four hundred fifty six (1,456) hours per calendar year. It is further stated that conditions of employment shall be explained to each employee.

SECTION 5: That Ordinance No. 16-055 and any ordinance inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Struthers, Ohio. Said emergency exists by reason of the fact; and as such, this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
