ZONING COMMITTEE MEETING

A meeting of the Zoning Committee took place in my office on October 5th in reference to a zone change proposal from the Struthers Federal Credit Union on Poland Avenue.

The Zoning Committee has scheduled a Public Meeting with neighboring residents that would be affected by this proposed zone change on Monday, November 19th at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers. The public is invited and asked to voice their opinions and concerns at this time.

The Struthers Federal Credit Union proposes to apply for a conditional use permit to allow exclusively for the construction of the Credit Union. The local business will provide the community with an indoor banking service and drive thru ATM and teller lane in a safe, centralized location.

FY2011 CDBG DOWNTOWN SIDEWALK & CURBING REPLACEMENT PROJECT ON LOWELLVILLE ROAD

The city will receive sealed bids for the above mentioned project on November 1st at 1:00 PM in Struthers City Hall. This project includes the replacement of curbing, sidewalk and driveway approaches on a section of Lowellville Road in the city from the east end of the Yellow Creek Bridge to a point approximately 300 feet east of the bridge. Also included is the installation of four decorative light pole foundations and conduit pipe to correspond with the Yellow Creek Bridge Improvement Project constructed by Mahoning County.
