

MAYOR'S REPORT
JUNE 13, 2012

LOWELLVILLE ROAD

The final legislation is before council which will entitle ODOT to move forward on this project; hopefully looking for the project to begin at the end of the summer or early fall.

The existing pavement is deficient and below city standards and project scope includes the resurfacing of Lowellville Road from SR616 east to the City of Struthers to Village of Lowellville corporate limits. The project includes pavement planning and installation of asphalt concrete surface course in accordance with ODOT. Two inches of asphalt will be removed and installed. Incidentals to the project include ramps installed with associated sidewalk and curbing, catch basin inlet adjustments, manhole adjustments, valve box adjustment and pavement striping.

201 AREA BOUNDARY MAHONING COUNTY

A recent inquiry to develop an area located in the northeast corner of Beaver Township, located in the area of east Western Reserve Road and South Avenue has identified this to be a part of the Struthers 201 Planning Area. In reviewing the area for potential sanitary sewer service, the most advantageous route would be to extend service from an existing manhole located on the south side of east Western Reserve Road.

We have requested support to amend the Struthers 201 area and add the area of this development into the Boardman 201 area.

MOVING OHIO FORWARD DEMOLITION PROGRAM UPDATE
