CITY OF STRUTHERS Ordinance

NO. <u>22-001</u>

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING HOLIDAYS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF STRUTHERS, OHIO AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 99-9834 AND ANY ORDINANCE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, ³/₄'s of all members thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the following designated dated to wit: Martin Luther King Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day are hereby designated as legal holidays. In the event that any of the legal holidays shall fall on a Saturday, the Friday immediately proceeding shall be observed as the Holiday. In the event the legal holiday shall fall on a Sunday, the Monday succeeding shall be observed as the holiday. If an employee's work schedule is other than Monday through Friday, he shall be entitled to holiday pay for holidays observed on his day off regardless of the day of the week on which they are observed.

SECTION 2: That some departments (bargaining units) may negotiate different day other than those listed above.

SECTION 3: That Ordinance No. 99-9834 is hereby repealed and any other ordinance inconsistent herewith effective January 1, 2022.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Struthers, Ohio. Said emergency exists by reason of the fact that it is necessary to establish and declare what holidays are to be recognized for those employees who must work on said dates, and, as such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
