## CITY OF STRUTHERS Ordinance

## AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF A PART-TIME SECURITY OFFICER FOR DOOR SECURITY AT COUNCIL MEETINGS AND AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO PAY AN ESTIMATED FOUR HOURS PER MONTH AT THE RATE OF \$14.50 FOR SAID POSITION FROM THE CONTINGENCY FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Council desires to create the position of a part-time security officer for door security at Council's regular and committee meetings.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDINANED** by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>'s of all members thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1:** Council hereby creates the position of a part-time security officer for door security at Council's regular and committee meeting on Wednesday evenings ("<u>Security Officer</u>"). The Security Officer shall be selected by the President of Council, and the President of Council shall supervise the Security Officer.

**SECTION 2:** The Security Officer shall be required to work approximately four (4) hours per month and receive an hourly wage of \$14.50. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to pay the Security Officer from the City's contingency fund. The Security Officer shall not receive any fringe benefits.

**SECTIN 3:** This Ordinance is retroactive to January 1, 2022.

**SECTION 4:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open in the public, in compliance with law.

**SECTION 5:** A delay in the effective date of this ordinance will result in detriment to the economic health, safety and welfare of the Struthers community at large. Accordingly, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
