**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR THE SALE OF STRUTHERS
POLICE DEPARTMENT K9 OFFICER RECON TO THE CITY
OF CANFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, K9 Officer Recon joined the Struthers Police Department in July 2022;

WHEREAS, since joining the Struthers Police Department, K9 Officer Recon’s handler has been Officer Dalton Moore;

WHEREAS, Officer Moore’s employment with the Struthers Police Department ended on November 30, 2024, and Officer Moore is now employed with the City of Canfield Police Department;

WHEREAS, the City of Canfield is willing to purchase K9 Officer Recon from the City of Struthers for \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, because Officer Moore is no longer employed with the Struthers Police Department, this Council finds that it is no longer necessary, practical, or for the best interest of the City of Struthers to retain ownership of K9 Officer Recon and, thus, this Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Struthers to sell K9 Officer Recon to the City of Canfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$ ’s of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: This Council approves the sale of K9 Officer Recon to the City of Canfield for the sum of \$10,000.00. The Mayor, Safety Service Director, and/or Police Chief are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to consummate the sale of K9 Officer Recon by the City of Struthers to the City of Canfield.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City and for the efficient daily operation of the City’s departments, specially including, but not necessarily limited to, the Police Department. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
