AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LINDY PAVING GROUP, 1807 SHENANGO ROAD, NEW GALILEE, PENNSYLVANIA 16141 FOR THE PAVING OF CREED STREET, LINCOLN STREET, ELM COURT, WEST LEWIS STREET, AND BOB CENE WAY FOR A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND 15/100 DOLLARS (\$884,882.15) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, previously directed the Service Director to advertise for bids for the paving of Creed Street, Lincoln Street, Elm Court, West Lewis Street and Bob Cene Way; and

WHEREAS, the City received multiple bid proposals; and;

WHEREAS, the bids for said project have been submitted and the City Council wishes to proceed with the street paving project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$'s of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Council hereby authorizes the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Lindy Paving Group, 1807 Shenango Road, New Galilee, Pennsylvania 16141, the lowest and best bidder, for the paving of the following streets in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Director of Public Service:

SECTION 2: A copy of said engineering drawings is marked Exhibit "A" and attached hereto and made hereby a part thereof.

SECTION 3: The total cost for said project shall not exceed \$884,882.15 and shall be funded from the OPWC Loan, OPWC Grant/Match and Street Levy Fund # 215 7000 55001.

SECTION 4: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: All formal actions of the City Council of Struthers, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Struthers, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the public as required by law.

SECTION 6: That it is FOUND and DETERMINED that all formal actions of this Council relating to the passage of this Resolution or adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were made in compliance with all legal requirements, including those of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Struthers, Ohio, by virtue of the fact that this project needs to be completed in the earliest time possible in order to maintain adequate traffic control and
