***AN ORDINANCE CREATING § 305.13 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF STRUTHERS REQUIRING
ANY PERSON OR ENTITY PERFORMING CONSTRUCTION
OR WORK WITHIN THE CITY THAT NECESSITATES THE
BLOCKING OR CLOSING OF CERTAIN STREETS TO NOTIFY
THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR THAT THE
CONSTRUCTION OR WORK IS TO BE PERFORMED AND TO
COMPLY WITH ANY AND ALL REQUIREMENTS THAT THE
SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR DETERMINES TO BE
NECESSARY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.***

WHEREAS, to protect the safety and welfare of the public, this Council finds it necessary to require any person or entity performing construction or work within the City that necessitates the blocking or closing of certain streets to (i) notify the Safety Service Director that the construction or work is to be performed and (ii) comply with any and all requirements that the Safety Service Director determines to be necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$'s of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: § 305.13 of the City's Codified Ordinances is hereby created to read as follows:

**§ 305.13 DUTY TO NOTIFY SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR WHEN CONSTRUCTION
OR WORK NECESSITATES THE BLOCKING OR CLOSING OF
DESIGNATED STREETS**

- (a) Whenever a Designated Street, any intersection thereof, and/or any sidewalk, driveway, approaches, devil strips, and/or curbs thereon, are required to be blocked or closed, whether wholly or partially, because of construction or work to be performed by any person or entity within the City, the person or entity responsible for the construction or work shall notify the Safety Service Director that the construction or work is to be performed, and the person or entity shall comply with any and all requirements that the Safety Service Director determines, in his/her sole discretion, to be necessary to ensure the safe and efficient movement of motor vehicles and pedestrians, including, but not limited to, signage, flaggers, law enforcement, or other traffic control measures.
- (b) The person or entity responsible for the construction or work shall also adhere to the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- (c) All costs associated with complying with the requirements established by the Safety Service Director pursuant to division (a) hereof shall be borne by the person or entity responsible for the construction or work.
- (d) As used in this § 305.13(a), "Designated Street" shall mean the following streets within the City of Struthers: State Route 170 (Youngstown Poland Road), State Route 616 (Struthers Poland Road, Poland Avenue, S. Bridge Street, and N. Bridge Street), Lowellville Road, State Street, Fifth Street, Center Street, Clingan Road, Sexton Street, Midlothian Blvd., Broad Street, Wetmore Drive, Runge Blvd., Overlook Blvd., and Geneva Avenue.
- (e) Failure to comply with the requirements hereof and/or with any requirements determined

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SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Struthers and, provided it receives the two-thirds (2/3) vote of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
