NO. 26-051

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DESIGNATED OUTDOOR
REFRESHMENT AREA ON JULY 12, 2026, AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2026, the Union Pacific Big Boy No. 4014 (the “Big Boy”), the world’s largest operating steam locomotive, is making a historic stop in downtown Struthers;

WHEREAS, to commemorate the arrival of the Big Boy, the City is planning a community celebration with different vendors and live music acts throughout the day;

WHEREAS, Donavito’s Restaurant & Catering Co., Selah Restaurant, and Monk’s Pub & Grub are located in the downtown area, and each has a liquor license issued by the State of Ohio;

WHEREAS, to enhance the experience of the community, the City desires to create a Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (“DORA”); and

WHEREAS, the DORA would permit Donavito’s Restaurant & Catering Co., Selah Restaurant, and Monk’s Pub & Grub to sell alcoholic beverages to individuals aged 21 and older and allow the individuals to carry the alcoholic beverages outdoors and consume them while walking around designated boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, ¾’s of all members elected thereto concurring:

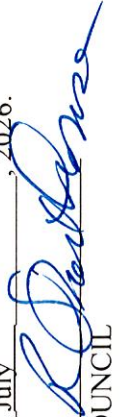
SECTION 1: Council hereby approves the establishment of a DORA comprised of the area depicted on Exhibit “A” hereto, which area includes and encompasses the premises of Donavito’s Restaurant & Catering Co., Selah Restaurant, and Monk’s Pub & Grub.

SECTION 2: The DORA shall operate between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Beer and/or intoxicating liquor shall be served in plastic bottles, cups, and/or other containers.

SECTION 3: Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including § 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: A delay in the effective date of this Ordinance will result in detriment to the health, safety and welfare of the Struthers community at large. Accordingly, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
